2. The Ministry of Gender, Children, and Social Protection now invites eligible individuals to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested individuals should provide information demonstrating they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services.
3. The shortlisting criteria are:

The individual submitting Expression of Interest must fulfill the following requirements:

- A. Master's degree in Economics, Agricultural Economics, or Statistics. Additional specialized postgraduate training in impact evaluation is preferred.
- B. At least 10 years of experience designing MEALKM systems for development project(s).

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- C. Skills in document design (MS Word or Google Docs), database maintenance (MS Access, MS Excel, or Google Sheets), and visual presentations (MS PowerPoint or other tools).
- D. Minimum of 5 years of experience coordinating surveys for impact evaluation, including the design of household survey instruments and the management of large-scale household surveys.
- E. Experience working on at least 3 rigorous impact evaluations with a counterfactual research design (e.g. RCTs).
- F. Minimum of 5 years of working experience in bilateral or multilateral donor-funded programs with at least 4 years of specific responsibility as a Survey Specialist, Poverty Economist, or M&E Specialist, and familiarity with the Government of Liberia Gender's Policies.
